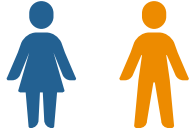


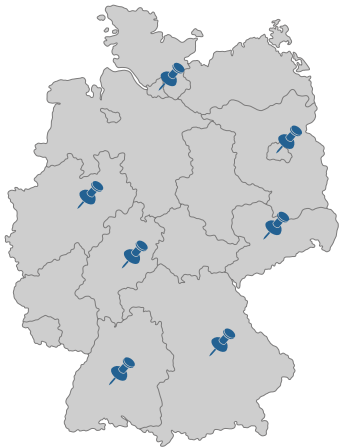
# Short Facts

## Activities – Examples

### 1 MENTORING

In 2020, the mentoring programme was launched with students of the **Master's programme "Master in Global Energy Transition and Governance" of the Franco-German CIFE Institute**. YEPs provide students with information on the energy industry as well as on starting a career in the energy sector.

### 2 COOPERATION EAST

The Eastern Cooperation Working Group exchanges information with the **networks of young researchers of the Eastern and South-Eastern European WEC members**. The aim is not only to exchange content but also to promote cross-border cooperation between the networks. The focus of the exchange of experience is on current project activities (e.g. setting up a women's network; podcast production).

### 3 PODCAST

Since 2020, the YEPs have had their own podcast in which they talk to various experts from business, civil society and politics and discuss current topics related to the energy transition. **The "Young Energy Podcast" can be found on Spotify.**

### 4 POLICY LUNCH

At the "Policy Lunch" format, a **regular exchange takes place on political and regulatory topics**. In dialogue with people from the political and public sphere the YEPs exchange their points of view and knowledge and thereby strengthen their network, in Berlin, Brussels and across Europe.
